

Sugaring Off is a painting by the American artist Grandma Moses. It represents the final collection of sap, the liquid in a tree that carries the food to all the parts of the tree. These are maple trees¹, and maple syrup² will be made from this sap. A lot of people are participating in this activity. It is a very happy event. There are pails³ attached to the trunks of the trees to collect the sap. Some people are working and carrying the pails full of sap to the barrels. Other people are riding on sleds⁴, chatting or simply watching the scene.
